

# Constantine's Church Hall is in danger of being sold and re-developed as housing. Have your say on this important issue by completing our short survey.

You may be aware that the Parochial Church Council is not renewing its lease on this building and that it therefore may be sold or re-developed as housing. The Church itself is being altered inside with the aim that many of the activities that formerly took place in the Church Hall can now take place in the Church.

Last year, at the request of the Parish Council, the building was registered as a Community Asset, which means if, or when, the building is placed on the market, Constantine Community has 6 months to raise funds to buy the building.
